### **Declutter**

"Take only what you need," says every senior that has moved into a retirement community.

#### Paperwork

- Put your files in a portable file box.
- Organize your taxes and other important paperwork.
- Put warranties and appliance instructions into a large envelope to leave for the family that will be moving in.

#### Identify what you want to move to your new apartment.

- Use labels or colored dots.
- If you've already decided which room in your new home each items goes, go ahead and label those, too.
- Don't be overwhelmed. Just start with one room at a time.

#### Anything that isn't labeled is what you will be discarding.

- Pick a different color dot for what you plan to give to family members. Be sure to talk about this with them beforehand so you aren't saving something they don't want.
- Last are the items that you will <u>not</u> take with you and aren't meant for family and friends. These items can be marked to sell, donate or discard.
