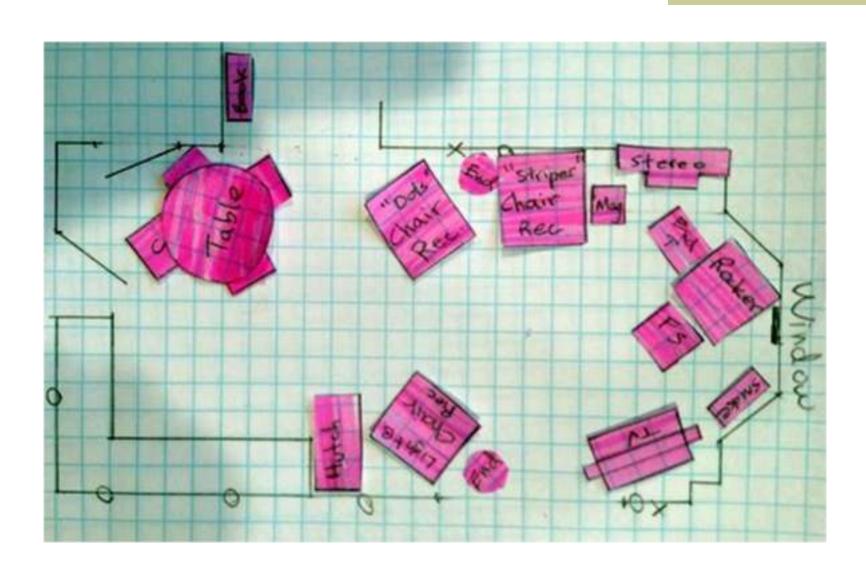
What's holding you back?

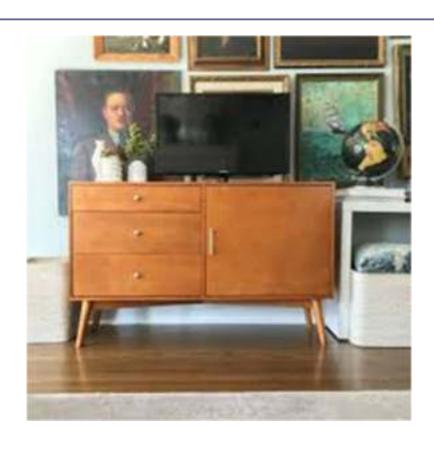
First step create a floor plan

Smaller scale furniture



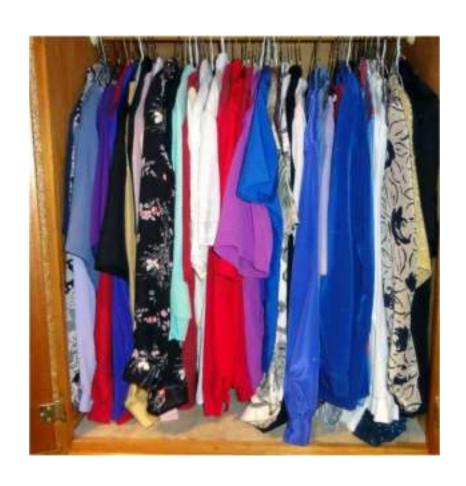
How to get started

Sort first, then pack



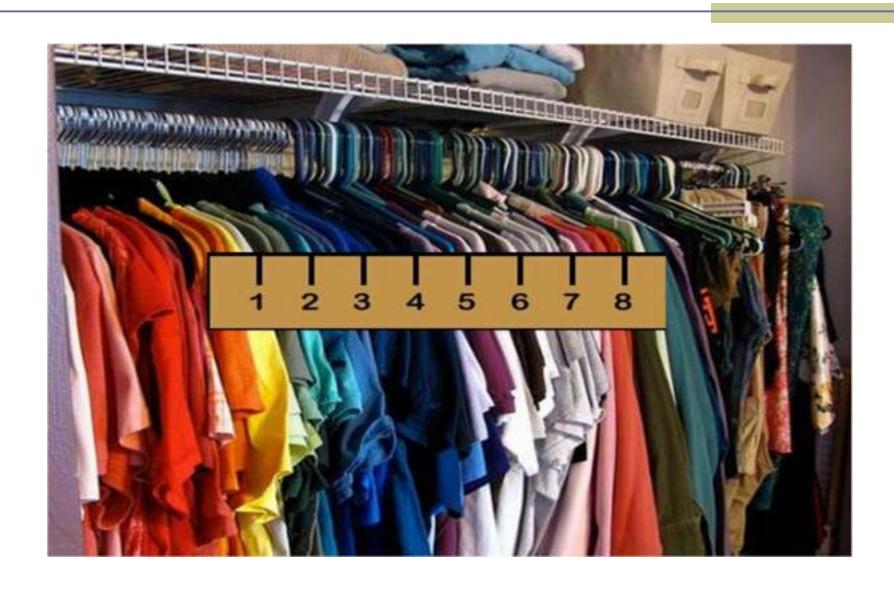
Three biggies—clothes, books, paper

AND Kitchens

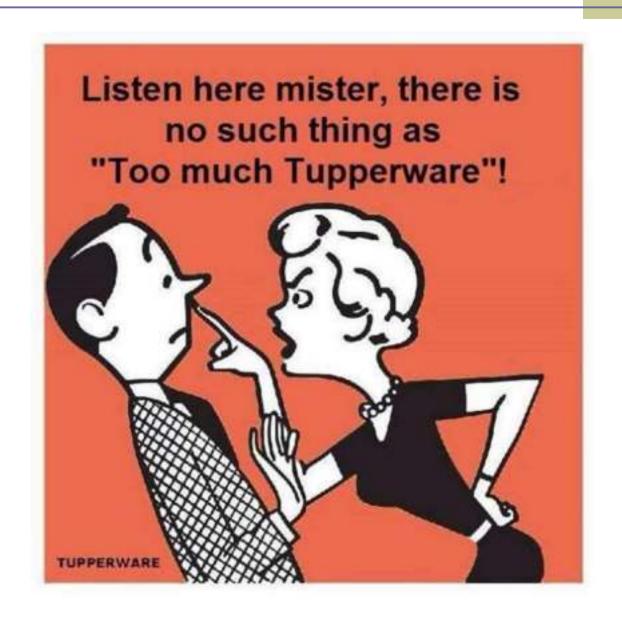


Duplicate utensils?

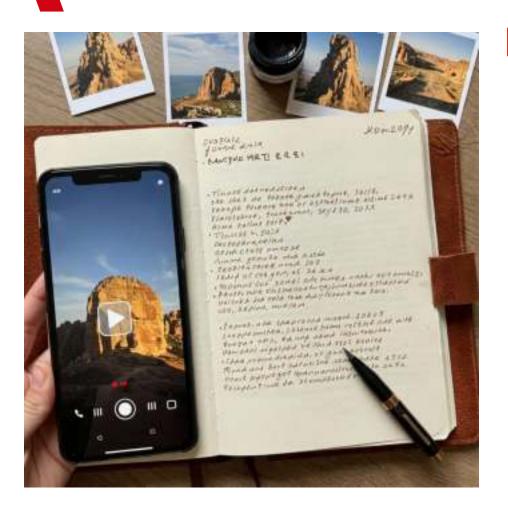




A Challenge of Downsizing: The Emotional Hurdle

 themselves must go.

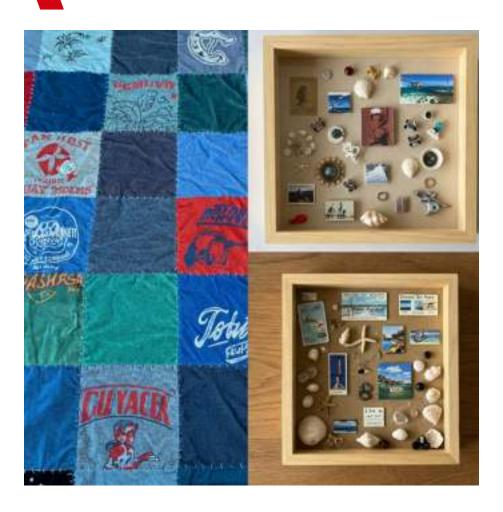
Combing through Keepsakes

- Written Stories: Journaling, memory books, or blog posts to document the significance of each piece.

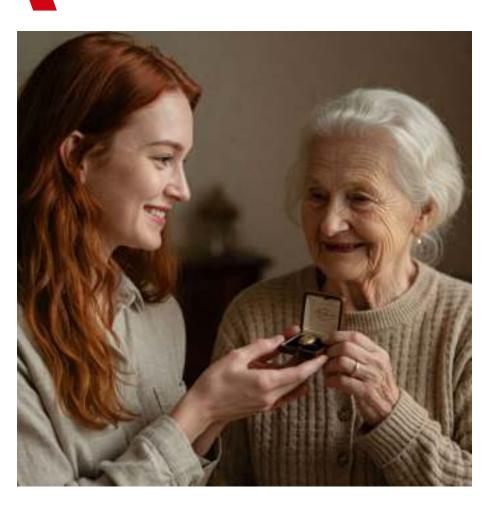
Capturing The Essence

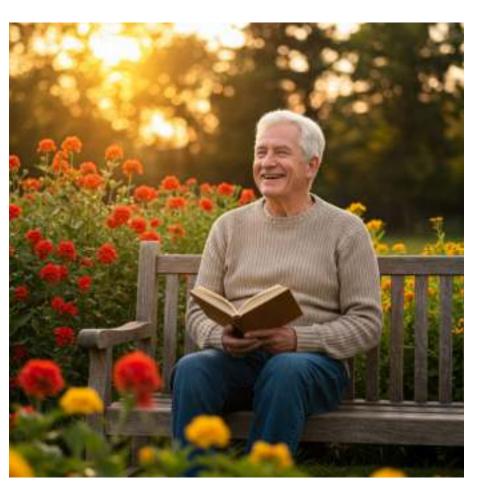

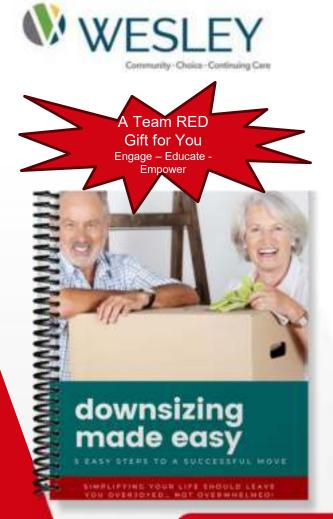


Embracing the Memories
